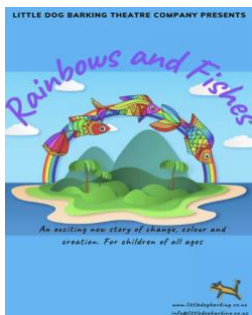
Welcome back to another term of learning and fun!
